Subject: Commencement of Class-XI for the academic year 2025-26 in EMRSs after the completion of the Board examinations of Class X- reg.

As per the vacation policy circulated by NESTS, EMRSs are following 60 days' vacation in all EMRSs and the vacation schedule is circulated for the academic session 2025-26 by NESTS vide letter no. NESTS/H-2/6/Acad. Plan/2025-26/1572 dated 04.03.2025 Further with regard to non-board classes, directions have been issued to begin the classes of next academic session i.e. 2025-26, after the completion of term end examination in March 2025 without allowing the students to leave the campus. Students are to be permitted to go home, only as per the vacation schedule circulated by NESTS.

With regard to present class X students, it has been decided by the competent authority to begin the academic transactions of class XI, immediately after the completion of Class X board examination (CBSE/State). Stream allotment may be done on the basis of performance in all internal assessments of Class X and they have to be permitted to go home, only as per the vacation schedule circulated by NESTS along with other students. This arrangement is made to provide additional academic input to our students who may be deprived of similar facility, if they are permitted to go home immediately after the board examination. Further it is a fact that the level of learning at secondary and senior secondary levels are different and hence 10 days' bridge courses with basic concepts in respective subjects may be strengthened for the students before focusing on class XI syllabus.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.
